Commissioner's Corner

Hello Sunset Beach! The change in the seasons has been quite noticeable this year. The temperatures have cooled, especially the gulf temps. The other season that ended with a bang was election season. Statewide it was a low turnout. Experts say it was attributable to all the negative campaigning. I know the mailman has it a bit easier without all the junk going out. I got it the first time, and for sure by the second time. By the 30th or 40th time I see the same ad I just forget it. Well the thing about elections is that there is always another around the corner. In March, not only will we vote for mayor, which is a 3 year term, but the commission will be asking the voters for some pin pointed height and density increases in what is called "Planned Development". All of the proposed density increase is hotel, none is residential. The experts say there is a big difference in those 2 when it comes to storm evacuation routes, as tourists are more apt to either not come or to leave early when the forecast is less than desirable. The proposed height increase will be from today's allowable 5 living floors, 62 feet above what is called "base flood elevation", or BFE, to 8 living floors and 98 feet above BFE. I say pinpointed because the areas in this proposal are the hotel area on the Gulf side between 104th Av to 119th Av and the Gator's property on the north end of the city. Stay informed and vote!
